The following proposed amendment conforms with current practice: "Membership classifications shall be Regular, Senior, Life, Family and Associate. A Family membership shall be defined as two or more family members living at the same address. All members in good standing shall be voting members of QU and of the local chapters to which they belong." Amendment adopted.

Linda Keithley presented a quilt top (using the Friendship Star block) to outgoing President Cindy Grimord and thanked her for all her hard work over the past year.
