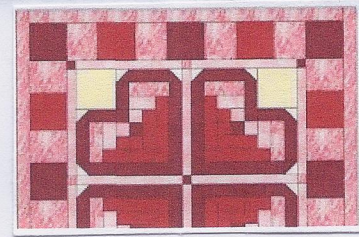


Block of the Month

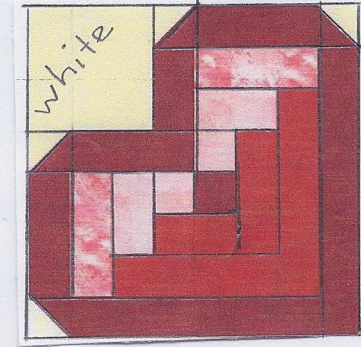


Pattern: Log Cabin Heart Block

Yields: (1) 12.5" unfinished block

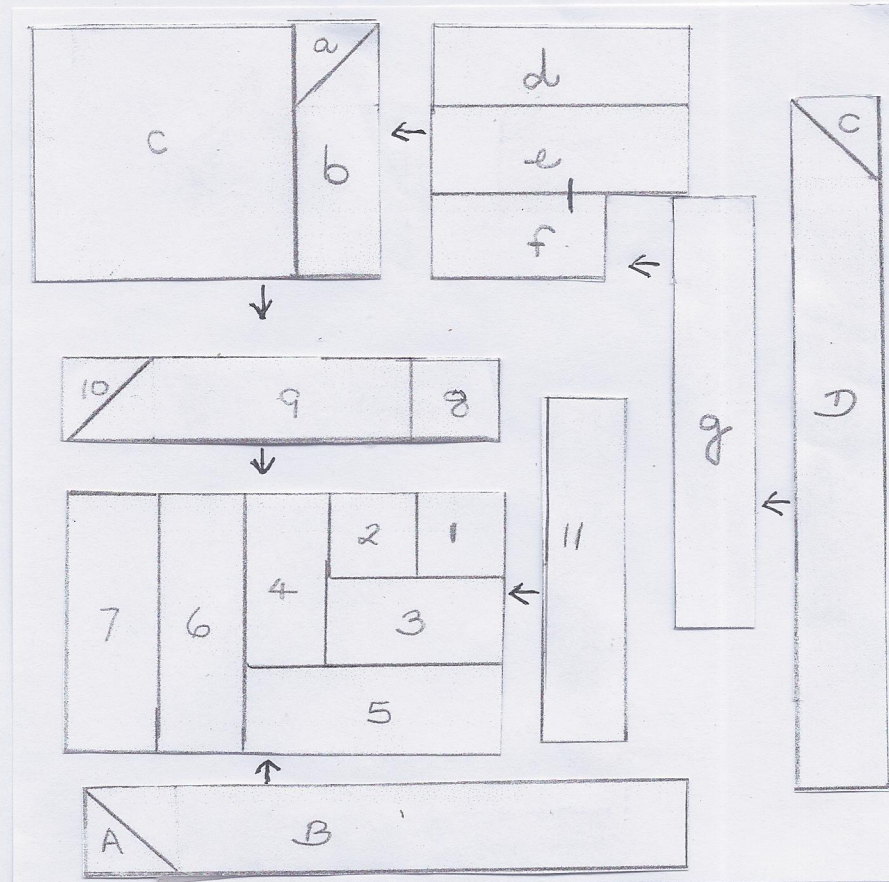
Fabrics: White or white-on-white for background

Assortment of deep reds through pale pinks for rest of block



Supplies:

- (1) 5" square in background white
- (4) 2" squares in background white, i.e. pieces (a), (A), (10) & (C) – draw a diagonal stitching line on back of each square. These squares will be placed on pieces (b), (9), (B) & (D) – be sure to orient them correctly
- (3) 2" squares for heart center
- (3) 3.5" x 2" strips
- (6) 5" x 2" strips
- (2) 6.5" x 2" strips
- (1) 8" x 2" strip
- (1) 11" x 2" strip
- (1) 12.5" x 2" strip



Directions:

Decide on how you want your heart block to look, e.g. a random medley of color, or a traditional log cabin block with lights on one side and darks on opposite side, or dark fabric on outer edges and lights within center of block. Your decision will dictate what fabric cuts to make.
