QU Wild Apricot for Members Phone App – If you use your phone for keeping up with information, download the Wild Apricot app and log in with your QU id and password. It's easy and always in the palm of your hand when you need to find someone or check on the events calendar.

QU Budget – The QU budget was presented and approved by the QU Board in August and is available for any member to request details from the QU Treasurer or your Chapter President. With the disposition of the QU storage locker contents, there will be an adjustment to reflect the reduction in this monthly expense.

QU Chapters – For current chapter updates, use the QU website and **login with your member info**. Each chapter has a page on the **MEMBER** Menu Option to display the chapter activities, their current newsletter and member only calendar view. This is a great resource for chapters and members to keep up to date.
